Solar Home Energy Audit Discount



Vermonters installing solar electricity qualify for an "Efficiency Adder" worth up to \$350 if they complete an energy audit performed by a Building Performance Institute certified or Home Performance with ENERGY STAR participating contractor, State Weatherization service provider, or Vermont Gas auditor (existing homes); or they participate in and complete the Vermont Energy Star Homes or Energy Code Plus program (new construction).
